## SUPPORTING VACCINE MANUFACTURING

Germany supports Ghana's endeavour to become a Pan-African vaccine manufacturing hub. In line with this, the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) has commissioned the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH to implement the **'Support to Vaccine Manufacturing in Ghana'** project. Over a 3-year-period (2021-2024) and with the aid of a BMZ 5million € funding grant, the vaccine project aims to contribute to creating an enabling environment for local vaccine production in Ghana and to support efforts of national governments and development partners in the fight against COVID-19. More specifically, the vaccine project supports Ghana's Presidential Vaccine Manufacturing Committee in the implementation of their 10-year roadmap towards transforming Ghana into a vaccine manufacturing hub in the sub-region.

Under the brand Team Europe, the German Development Cooperation and the European Union have also initiated a 2.8 million € support for the institutional and technical strengthening of the Ghana Food and Drugs Authority, to enable it regulate vaccine production. With extra funding of 2 million € from Sondermittel, the vaccine team is supporting Ghana's national COVID-19 vaccination campaign. Implementing partners are the Ghana Health Service, **African German Health Association**, Clinton Health Initiative, and World Vision.



**As part of the ambitions, the following five working packages are jointly implemented in Ghana between July and September 2022.**



## 1 INCREASE ACCEPTANCE

### Increase Acceptance of COVID-19 Vaccination for Clinical and Non-Clinical Hospital Personnel

This campaign aims to increase acceptance of COVID-19 vaccination among clinical and non-clinical hospital personnel by implementing the following elements at healthcare facilities:

- Workshop to develop campaign materials
- Development of a COVID-19 vaccination promotion video clip and campaign materials
- Implementation of campaign in up to ten hospitals
- Survey and raffle for healthcare personnel

## 2 DIGITAL TRACKING

### Knowledge Exchange and Capacity Building
